It is explained that we find a shortage of Speech Pathologists and Occupational Therapists, so partnering with a variety of vendors is key.

Marcella Nino asks for clarification on Speech Services and the type of counseling students receive.

Cassandra Bolden inquires as to parents requesting counseling or behavioral health services, but may not be a family receiving special education.

Celeste explains that when a general education student requires counseling, we partner with Julian Pathways that provides that service.
